For each player enrolled, a minimum of five (5) volunteer hours will need to be completed either by that player or someone on their behalf. Numerous opportunities will be given throughout the year and advertised as far in advance as possible so everyone will be able to find something that fits their schedule. Below are some examples of ways you will be able complete the requirement:

Volunteer at a GBCIHA fundraiser

Serve on the GBCIHA Board, Appointed Position, Committee Chair, Coach a team or serve as a Team Manager

Volunteer at a GBCIHA sponsored tournament

Volunteer at one of the GBCIHA Family Skates

Run the game clock for a game other than your own child's

Work a shift at the Calhoun County Fair

Simply write a check to GBCIHA for \$150 to complete the requirements

* This requirement is in addition to any requirements if you receive a David Wallace Scholarship

This fee will be charged up front at registration, unless the player/parent has already donated their time for the upcoming season. Once the hours are completed, the amount is deducted from the family's final ice bill.
